

Merit Scholarship Application

Merit Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis. Not all students who apply are awarded a scholarship. Your completed scholarship application and CD of work must be postmarked by the February 15, 2010 deadline to qualify. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

All Merit Scholarships are applied toward tuition only; they do not cover supplies or the campus residence package (room and board.)

What to submit:

- Completed scholarship application
- High School Transcripts
- Samples of work (portfolio):
 - Students applying for the scholarship must submit 5 to 10 examples of their work on a CD (jpeg format). The portfolio may contain works in all media, but should include at least three drawings from observation (still-life or figure). Paintings as well as sculpture, ceramics, jewelry, printmaking, photography, and other media may be submitted. Applicants should include some work in their chosen elective if possible.

Scholarship applications will be reviewed by a panel and graded on the following:

- Composition
- Conceptual Ability
- Hand Skills
- Control of Media/ Technical Skills
- Use of Light/ Dark/ Shading
- Use of Color
- Exploration of Space
- GPA
